## Starting 20 Years

This year we being 20 years of regular publication of ZOOS' PRINT magazine. When we started ZOOS' PRINT in 1985 end with the first issue coming out on 1 January 1986, experienced people in the zoo profession in India laughed! "We can't get zoo people to write enough even for a quarterly bulletin! and you're aiming for a monthly magazine?"

Wondering ourselves how we would fill even 16 pages, we said we would write about zoos ourselves, reprint useful material and news and encourage people to write with a very liberal editorial policy. And this is what we did ... after a very few months of circulating ZOOS' PRINT — free for zoos and relevant governmental officials, and people who might start a Friends of the Zoo, etc., etc., etc., we began to get contributions of articles, news, notes, features and even stories from zoo and wildlife personnel as well as voluntary organisations. We published them immediately so as to give immediate, positive reinforcement.

It took us ten years to produce our first Index, but after the first 10 year Index published in 1995 (it was really a nine year index I guess!), we have published an index every year. The same year we published a subject and author index, we also published a word index. We will save the next word index for 2006, when we celebrate 20 years of continuous circulation.
