

Education for a Sustainable Future' (ESF)

2005-2014 has been declared by the United Nations General Assembly as the Decade for Education for Sustainable Development. To mark the beginning of the Decade, Centre for Environment Education, India, in partnership with Ministry of Environment and Forests and Ministry of Human Resource Development, UNESCO and UNEP, is organizing an international conference 'Education for a Sustainable Future' (ESF), between January 18-20, 2005.



The conference is expected to contribute significantly in giving direction to the Decade's activities. The objective is to share experiences and best practices in "Education for Sustainable Development" (ESD), and to develop a blueprint of action for ESD. The developing country perspective is a key learning to be shared through the Conference.
