

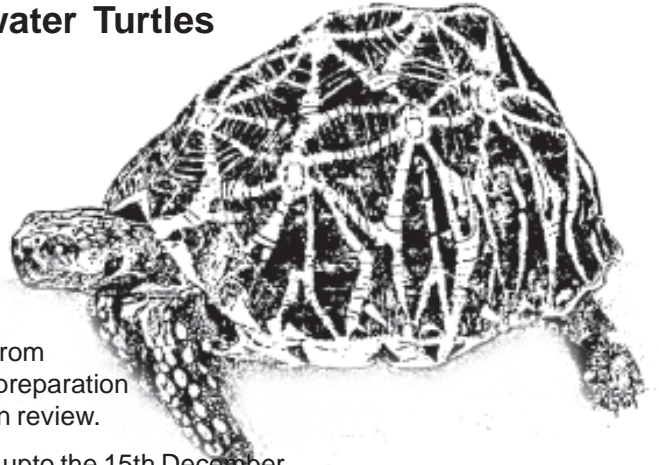
# Conservation and Action Plan for Freshwater Turtles and Tortoises of India

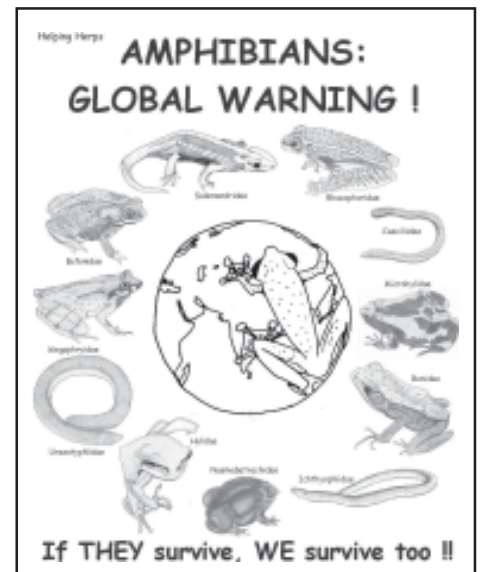
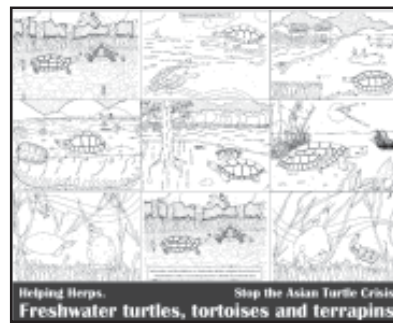
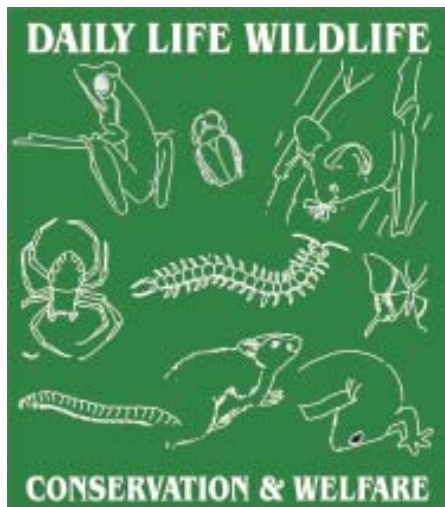


### Introduction
